

COMMINGLING Order No. MU 7718

MADE at the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, on

1st day of February 2011.

ENERGY RESOURCES CONSERVATION BOARD

The Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB) pursuant to the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, chapter O-6 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, orders as follows:

1) The following table shows the specified pools and wells in the **Burnt Timber Field** wherein production may be commingled in the wellbore:

Pools	Wells (Unique Identifier)
Burnt Timber Cardium A and Burnt Timber Cardium B	00/09-23-31-08W5M
Burnt Timber Cardium C and Burnt Timber Viking A	All
(1)Burnt Timber Rundle A, (1)Burnt Timber Rundle B, and (1)Burnt Timber Wabamun A	All (See Clauses 2, 3, and 4)
Burnt Timber Rundle D and Burnt Timber Rundle E	All
Burnt Timber Banff A, Burnt Timber Wabamun B and Burnt Timber Arcs A	All

- 2) The gas production from the Burnt Timber Rundle A, Burnt Timber Rundle B and Burnt Timber Wabamun A Pools shall be prorated to the Burnt Timber Rundle A and Rundle B Pools, and the Burnt Timber Wabamun A Pool on the basis of annually measured hydrogen sulphide concentration.¹
- 3) If total water production from the wells within the pools referenced to in clause 2 increases significantly, the operator shall determine the source of the incremental water production and take appropriate action necessary to prevent it from affecting gas recovery.¹
- 4) For each new well within the pool referenced to in clause 2, the operator shall conduct an appropriate test on each individual zone to be commingled to determine initial reservoir pressure and gas flow rate.
