
## Teck Resources Ltd. • Frontier Oil Sands Mine Project

The Joint Review Panel (the Panel) established to review the proposed Frontier Oil Sands Mine Project (the Project) and conduct an assessment of the environmental effects of the Project has determined that the proponent, Teck Resources Ltd. (Teck), has provided sufficient information for the Panel to hold a public hearing for the Project. This notice is a summary of how to request to participate in the hearing.



# The hearing

Notice

A hearing will be scheduled to consider the Project, which includes the construction, operation and reclamation of an oil sands surface mine with a production capacity of about 41 300 m3/day (260,000 barrels per day) of bitumen. The Project is located in northeastern Alberta, approximately 110 kilometres north of Fort McMurray.

If you have an interest in the Project and wish to file a submission, submit evidence, participate or make a statement at the hearing, and have not already been given participation rights by the Panel, you must file a written request to participate in the hearing by **noon MDT June 22, 2018**.
