1 DECISION

The Energy Resources Conservation Board (ERCB/Board) hereby approves Application No. 1684351, noting that it meets ERCB requirements and that a withdrawal of objection from the intervening party has been received.

2 APPLICATION

Pengrowth Energy Corporation (Pengrowth) applied, pursuant to Part 4 of the *Pipeline Act*, for approval to construct and operate a pipeline for the purpose of transporting produced water with a maximum hydrogen sulphide concentration of 2.00 moles per kilomole (0.2 per cent) from Legal Subdivision (LSD) 4 of Section 32, Township 13, Range 16, West of the 4th Meridian, to an existing well at LSD 15-32-13-16W4M. The proposed pipeline would be about 1.95 kilometres (km) in length with a maximum outside diameter of 106.00 millimetres. The proposed pipeline would be located about 7.5 km northwest of Vauxhall, Alberta.

An objection to the application was filed by George Wall and Jessie Wall. Pengrowth engaged in the ERCB's Appropriate Dispute Resolution program with the interveners on July 27, 2011. The parties continued the negotiation process and reached an agreement on their own.

3 DISCUSSION

The Board assigned a panel to consider this application which comprised of Board Member G. Eynon, P.Geol. (Presiding Member) and External Acting Board Members J. Gilmour, B.A., LL.B. and H. R. Heffler, M.Eng. On August 29, 2011, the Board received a withdrawal of objection from the intervening party. Accordingly, a public hearing will not be held.
